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Have You Renewed Your License for 2018?

IMPORTANT REMINDER

All Board-issued licenses expire on December 31st

As of November 27th, the Board's records indicated that there were still 6,224 of our 14,234 licensees who have not yet renewed their license for 2018. In other words, 66% of the way through the renewal period, only 56% of licensees have renewed.

If you are among the 44% who hasn't yet renewed your license, please try do so as soon as possible, so that you can avoid the issues that will arise if your license expires.

If not renewed by December 31st, the license will expire on that date. What that means is that on January 1, 2018, the licensee (as well as their firm and employees) cannot legally engage in any work which requires a license after that date.

Local inspection departments will check to see if the license is valid before issuing permits, and if the license is expired the permit will not be issued. Code Officials may also issue Stop Work Orders on any jobs that are in progress until the license is renewed, and any licensee or firm who continues to engage in activities requiring a license while expired may face disciplinary action from the Board for doing so without a valid license.

Licenses that expired in 2017 may be renewed during the month of January, 2018 without a late renewal processing fee. Please understand that January is not a "grace period" of any sort for the license. It is simply an opportunity to renew an expired 2017 license without paying a late fee. On February 1, 2018, the late renewal fee of \$25.00 will be added to the renewal fee.

Licenses that expired in 2014, 2015 or 2016 may be renewed before December 31, 2017, by paying all licensing back fees and the late renewal fee. On January 1, 2018, licenses that expired in 2014 will be placed in 'Retired' status and cannot be renewed. In order to reinstate a retired license, the individual must reapply to the Board and pass the required examination(s).

Current year licenses may be renewed using our online portal if there are no changes in the trade name or any sub-licensees. Paper renewal forms were mailed to the address of record for all licenses during early October, and contain the Username and Password needed for online renewal. If you wish to renew online and did not receive or have lost your form, you may call our office for assistance.

If you wish to renew by paper form and a check or money order, and did not receive or have lost your form, renewal forms may be downloaded from our website and mailed to or brought by our office for processing.

If you did not receive a renewal form by mail, please use the License Search feature on our website to verify that your mailing address is correct. If not, please complete an Address Change Form (also available on the website) and mail, fax, or e-mail it to our office so that your record can be updated with the current and correct information.

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Laws & Rules Class Open to All

Each quarter, a four-hour class on the Board's Laws and Rules is presented in Raleigh and Statesville. The class is for those who are required to fulfill disciplinary requirements, but is also open to anyone else who wishes to attend. Current contractor and technician licensees will gain valuable information regarding the duties and responsibilities of a licensee. Unlicensed employees will gain insight into their roles while working under the supervision of licensees. Applicants will pick up information that may be helpful in passing the business portion of the examination.

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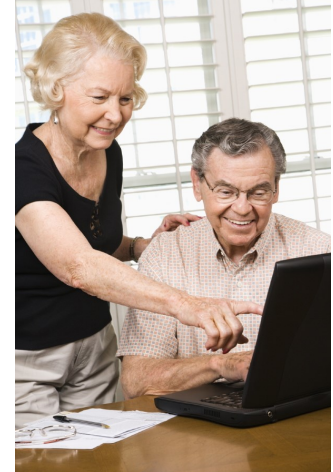

The Board is required by law to investigate every complaint received. If the findings of the investigation indicate that a violation of the laws and rules enforced by the Board have occurred by a licensed or unlicensed individual and/or firm, a number of disciplinary actions are available to the Board.

Letter of Caution Report

Upon completion of investigations, a Letter of Caution can be issued to a licensee where it is determined through an investigation that a violation has occurred by one of our licensees. Consent Agreement Report

A Consent Agreement is an affidavit taken from unlicensed individuals performing plumbing, heating and fire sprinkler work without a license. These individuals sign a Consent Agreement stating that they will not perform any work requiring a license until they are properly licensed to do so. If you see these individuals performing contracting activities in the field, please report them to this office.

Resolution Agreements

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. Listed below are the different agreements entered into by the field staff and the Resolution Review Committee that have been approved by the Board. The information below does not contain all of the facts or details of each case. Allegations of misconduct and incompetence in the business of heating contracting in that the licensee failed to obtain permit(s) prior to commencing work, failed to request inspections within 10 days of substantial completion of work, failed to respond to the customer in a timely manner, and failed to ensure proper system operation.

L.P. Everhart signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 10/05/2017.

The license of L.P. Everhart, number 09333 H2&3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course. In the event of violation of any of the conditions of probation, license of the individual and of the firm will be suspended for a period of six (6) months, with the requirement that prior to the suspended license being reinstated the licensee and the firm agrees to comply with all of the probation provisions.

The license of Rick Greene, number 11311 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course. In addition, by 09/01/2017, the contractor shall return to the home located at 118 Ewarts Pond Road and perform a thorough Manual J load calculation. If the load calculation reveals that the equipment is improperly sized, then the contractor shall obtain a permit from the local inspection department, replace the undersized or oversized equipment with properly sized air handler(s) and condensing unit(s) and obtain a final inspection by 09/08/2017. The contractor shall submit evidence to the board by 09/15/2017 of the final inspection and shall submit a copy of his load calculation. After complaint to the Board, the licen-

see completed the load calculation and obtained an approved final inspection. In the event of violation of any of the conditions of probation, license of the individual and of the firm will be suspended for a period of six (6) months, with the requirement that prior to the suspended license being reinstated the licensee and the firm agrees to comply with all of the probation provisions.
