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# **HVAC** Design Control and the Responsibility of the Licensee

Recently the Board held a formal hearing to address over 35 complaints made against a single contractor regarding HVAC systems installed by the licensee's firm.

Most of the complaints originated in homes that were built by the same tract builder and located in the same sub-division. It appears that the fact pattern was that the tract builder had several standard floorplans, each which provided a small HVAC equipment room on the second floor near the top of the stairs. All of the plenum, supply and return ductwork was expected to be installed in the space between the two floors of the house, in space equal to the depth of the floor joists.

During the hearing, another licensed contractor testified that his firm had reviewed the house plans, including the space provided for HVAC and the equipment room. After the review, his firm declined to perform the installations due to their belief that the space provided was inadequate and customer complaints were quite likely. This contractor also stated that he was not surprised when his firm began to receive calls regarding the homes in question, requesting them to assist the purchasers of the homes with redesign and/or reinstallation of the HVAC systems.

Nearly all of the owners who had purchased the homes complained of inadequate performance, significate temperature variations, and failure to meet the four-degree difference rule of the Board. The licensed contractor who was the subject of the hearing contended that the load calculations showed that the equipment selected was of adequate size to heat and cool the square footage of the structures.

The reality was that this equipment may have been barely adequate, but only with a nearly perfect duct system. In the cases discussed, the ductwork was deficient in both design and installation.

The Board held the heating contractor responsible to provide adequate ductwork and equipment to meet the four degree design standard of the Board. There was substantial evidence that the ductwork in the equipment room, the cramped space beneath the equipment room, and between and among the truss flooring system could never meet the design standards of the Board, and could not be modified to do so without tearing out virtually all of the ceilings and perhaps boxing in the plenums in a way not contemplated by the tract builders plan.

As a result of the numerous complaints against the licensee's firm, which had been in business for two generations, they went out of business before the Board hearing was held. Nevertheless, the licensee was still subject to discipline by the Board.

The question for licensed HVAC contractors is this: Who is better off today?

Is it the contractor who declined the project based on his knowledge of the design requirements, or the contractor who allowed the system design to be dictated by someone else?

Licensees are reminded that it is the responsibility of the licensee to use his or her knowledge to design a system that will function as intended and meet the performance standards set forth by the Board.

Why would anyone take a job when complaints and problems down the road are a virtual certainty, putting their license in jeopardy along with the future of the firm and the livelihood of the employees?

The Board's rules clearly address the licensee's responsibility with regards to the design and installation of HVAC systems, as well as the supervision of the work. Important excerpts of the rules are on the next page.

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Relevant portions of Board Rule NCAC 50.0505 are as follows:

(a) The general supervision required by G.S. 87-26 is that degree of supervision which is necessary and sufficient to ensure that the contract is performed in a workmanlike manner and with the requisite skill and that the installation is made properly, safely and in accordance with applicable codes and rules. General supervision requires that review of the work done pursuant to the license be performed by a licensee of the firm while the work is in progress. If a Plumbing, Heating or Fuel Piping Contractor licensed by this Board employs a properly licensed Plumbing, Heating or Fuel Piping Technician, whose Technician license is listed under the name of that licensed contractor, then the licensed technician may review and supervise work in lieu of the licensed contract

# **Resolution Agreements**

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. Listed below are the different agreements entered into by the field staff and the Resolution Review Committee that have been approved by the Board. The information below does not contain all of the facts or details of each case.
