Time is Running Out to Renew Your License

All licenses issued by the Board will expire on December 31, 2020!

Licenses not renewed by December 31st will not be valid on January 1, 2021. The licensee can not legally engage in any activity for which a license is required until the license is renewed. This includes, but is not limited to, bidding, quoting, contracting, obtaining permits, or performing any work which requires a license. Most, if not all, local permitting offices across the state routinely check the status of the license before issuing a permit and will deny the permit if the license is not current.

As of October 15th, with only six weeks remaining before the expiration of all licenses, there are still over 6,000 licensees who have not yet renewed their licenses.

Please renew your license as soon as possible, so you aren't one of those who is denied a permit in January because you allowed your license to expire.

Annual license renewals began on October 1, 2020, and renewal invoices were mailed to all active licensees. The notices contain the username and password, and licensees are encouraged to renew online. Renewal notices are mailed to the address of record. Licensees are responsible for updating any change of address with the Board within 30 days of such change. If you did not receive a renewal notice and wish to renew by mailing a paper form to the office, please visit the Forms page of our website and download the appropriate form. If you wish to renew online and did not receive a form with your username and password, please contact the Board's office for assistance.

Fees for licensees and sub-licensees were increased for the 2021 renewal, but are not retroactive and do not apply to previous years that have not yet been renewed.

Renewal invoices were also mailed to licensees whose license expired in 2017, 2018 & 2019; however, <u>those licenses can not be renewed online</u>. You must mail in the completed paper renewal form with a check or money order. For those who expired in 2017, if your renewal is not postmarked by December 31, 2020, your license will be retired. After that, the only way to reinstate it is to take and pass the required examination(s).

Disciplinary Classes Cancelled for Remainder of 2020 Due to COVID-19

Effective November 12, 2020, all scheduled Disciplinary Education classes have been cancelled through the end of 2020. This is in response to the increasing and record number of COVID-19 cases in North Carolina. The Board hopes to resume the normal quarterly scheduling of all classes in early 2021; however, any decisions going forward will be based on the latest pandemic information. When available, 2021 Disciplinary Education schedules will be posted on the Education page of the Board's website. Required attendance dates will be extended for all licensees affected by these actions.

These individuals sign a Consent Agreement stating that they will not perform any work requiring a license until they are properly licensed to do so. If you see these individuals performing contracting activities in the field, please report them to this office.

Resolution Agreements

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of John Davis, license number 30448, H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be suspended for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements, the license will be restored at the end of the suspension, provided that within thirty (30) days of approval of this agreement John Michael David shall refund to the homeowner the sum of \$3,912.50. Upon the 12-month active suspension imposed on successful completion of the suspension, his 01/14/2020, there were code violations, no permits or inspections, installation issues, and allegations of gross negligence and misconduct, and violated suspension in that the licensee contracted and / or performed work that requires a license while his license was suspended.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Cody Allen Seibert, number 34345 H-3-I, and that of the firm (Cool Breeze Heating & Air) shall be permanently revoked.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of James Wooten, license, number 34456, H3-II, and that of the firm, shall be placed on a supervised probation for a period of twelve months. The terms of the Proposed Resolution Agreement also include requirements, by 07/17/2020, that the licensee assure that his license has been listed with the Board in the name that he currently operates his business, assure that he only qualifies one location, by 07/30/2020, the contractor shall return to the homes, and perform a thorough Manual J load calculation and a Manual S equipment sizing calculation. Licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Attorney's Report
