Is Your License Active?

If you are one of the one-thousand or so individuals who has still not yet renewed your license for 2021, it is illegal for you to engage in any contracting activities until the license is renewed. Contracting activities include, but are not limited to, bidding, quoting, contracting, obtaining permits, or performing any work which requires a license. Most, if not all, local permitting offices across the state routinely check the status of the license before issuing a permit and will deny the permit if the license is not current.

Annual license renewals began on October 1, 2020, and renewal invoices were mailed to all active licensees. The notices contained the username and password, and licensees were encouraged to renew online. Renewal notices were mailed to the address of record. Licensees are responsible for updating any change of address with the Board within 30 days of such change. If you did not receive a renewal notice and wish to renew by mailing a paper form to the office, please visit the Forms page of our website and download the appropriate form. If you wish to renew online and did not receive a form with your username and password, please contact the Board's office for assistance.

Fees for licensees and sub-licensees were increased for the 2021 renewal, but are not retroactive and do not apply to previous years that have not yet been renewed. Renewal invoices were also mailed to licensees whose license expired in 2018 & 2019; however, those licenses can not be renewed online. You must mail in the completed paper renewal form with a check or money order. For those who expired in 2017 or before, if your renewal was not postmarked by December 31, 2020, your license has been retired. If the license is retired, the only way to reinstate it is to take and pass the required examination(s). Licenses not renewed by January 31, 2021 will be subject to a \$25.00 late renewal processing fee.

Disciplinary Classes Scheduled for 2021

Restrictions on indoor assemblies impacted the ability to hold many of the disciplinary classes as they were originally scheduled for 2020, and have left a large number of licensees awaiting an opportunity to attend and complete their course requirements.

The Board has published a schedule for the 2021 classes, with hopes that we will be able to hold them as planned. However, with the future still being quite uncertain at this point, it may be necessary to cancel classes or modify seating capacities of classes if required to do so by the Governor.

For those individuals who were assigned course requirements as a condition of a probation or suspension agreement, the original date of the probation or suspension completion will be honored, provided that any and all other requirements are met. Licensees who have probations or suspensions removed under this policy are expected to complete the required courses when they become available. Those who do not may face additional disciplinary action by the Board.

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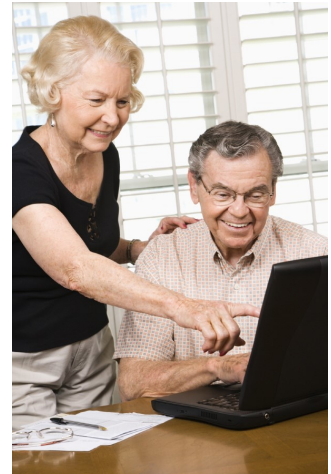

Resolution Agreements

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. Listed below are the different agreements entered into by the field staff and the Resolution Review Committee that have been approved by the Board. The information below does not contain all of the facts or details of each case. Allegations licensee falsified multiple water piping plumbing tests, violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Plumbing Code, and failed to provide supervision.

Resolution Conference held 09/04/2020.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Randy Beaty, number 31216 P-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of twenty-four (24) months. Upon successful completion of the suspension, his license, number 31216 P-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Plumbing Code and Design courses.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Rick Cooke, number 9068 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. The terms of the Proposed Resolution Agreement also include requirements for the licensee to maintain copies of all load calculations in each job file for a of a minimum of 6 years. If the load calculations are maintained digitally, appropriate computers backups shall exist to assure against computer failure, licensee shall enroll in,

attend and complete the series of Special Fuel Gas Code and Design courses and the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Allegations sublicensee, as the mechanical qualifier for All Trade Contractors, supervised the installation of a new Lennox 2-ton gas package unit serving the 1st floor and crawlspace areas of the home, a Lennox 2-ton split system serving the 2nd floor of the home and a complete duct system when the load calculation called for the installation of 1.7-ton system to service the 2nd floor and a 1.1-ton system to service the 1st and crawlspace areas of the approximate 3,300 total square foot home.

Russell Lee Dillard signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 10/21/2020.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Russell Dillard, number 33751 PH-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on an unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course, the series of Special Mechanical Design courses, and within seven (7) days of the approval of this order the contractor shall return to the home and perform a thorough Manual J load calculation, Manual D duct design and a Manual S equipment sizing calculation.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Donald Ford, number 20244 P-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on an unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course and submit to the Board's office within the next thirty (30) days copies of all employee W-4's and by the end of the probation submit a copy of all employee W-2's.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Michael Foust, number 23504 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Contractor Business Management courses.

The terms of the Proposed Resolution Agreement also include a requirement to enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Allegations licensee failed to perform load calculation, violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Mechanical Code, failed to properly construct a flexible duct joint, installed a 14" single return air on a 4-ton package unit installed in a home greater than 2200 sq. ft., where two return air were required by code.

Resolution Conference held 09/23/2020.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Samuel Todd, number 22453 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed

on unsupervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. The terms of the Proposed Resolution Agreement also include requirements to enroll in, attend and complete the series of Special Mechanical Code courses the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

The terms of the Proposed Resolution Agreement also include requirements to enroll in, attend and complete the series of Special Mechanical Code and Design courses and enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Attorney's Report

The Attorney's Report contains information pertaining to cases that have been adjudicated in a formal proceeding of the Board or in the courts of North Carolina. Disciplinary actions against licensed contractors are typically imposed during a Formal Hearing of the Board. Court action is necessary when unlicensed individuals are in violation of the Board's Laws and Rules or in circumstances where licensees are found to be in violation of any order(s) issued by the Board.
