Is Your Contact Information Up To Date?

There are currently over 15,000 active licensees of the Board, and about 11,000 have email addresses associated with them. Our goal is to have a valid email address for every active licensee in our database, which would give us the ability to contact everyone in a very timely manner.

We regularly attempt to send emails via the internet and "snail mail" through the U.S. Postal Service; unfortunately, we receive many notices of undeliverable emails and many pieces of returned mail due to incorrect or inactive addresses. This includes annual renewal invoices, newsletter publishing notifications, and information regarding special information such as upcoming classes, public hearings, or other events that are of importance to licensees. We also frequently find that the telephone numbers that we have are no longer active or no longer belong to the licensee.

These situations require extra time and effort by the Board staff in trying to find ways to contact licensees, but more importantly, it delays or prevents the staff from being able to share important, and often time sensitive, information with licensees.

Licensees can now log in and update their physical address, email address and telephone numbers online. You will need your Login ID and Password, which were listed on your recent annual renewal invoice. You may also use the links on the page to recover a forgotten User ID and/or reset your password. Please note that when changes are submitted, it is in the form of a request that must be reviewed by a staff member and approved before the changes will appear on the public license search information. A change needs to be submitted only once. Please allow 5-7 days for the change to appear, and do not submit more than one request.

- Book Order Form (Board Laws & Rules, Business & Project Management for Contractors)
- Reprint of License (annual renewal certificate or original gold-seal certificate)

- Listing of Applicants (for exam prep course providers to notify of upcoming classes)

Paper forms are still available for download on the Forms page of our website, and most are in fillable .pdf format. If you choose to submit a paper form by mail, please make sure that you are using the latest version available. If outdated forms are used it may delay processing due to incorrect or missing information, or fees in the wrong amount.

A copy of your annual certificate may also be printed through the renewal portal at no charge.

These individuals sign a Consent Agreement stating that they will not perform any work requiring a license until they are properly licensed to do so. If you see these individuals performing contracting activities in the field, please report them to this office.

Resolution Agreements

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. Listed below are the different agreements entered into by the field staff and the Resolution Review Committee that have been approved by the Board. The information below does not contain all of the facts or details of each case. Brady, Jerry Allen II West Shore Home, LLC Wilmington, NC License# 31335 P-I

Allegations licensee failed to withhold taxes and paid an unlicensed individual using a 1099 Form in violation of the Board rule 21 NCAC 50.0512.

Jerry Brady signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 01/08/2021.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Jerry Brady, number 31335 P-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on an unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the probation, submit to the Board's office within the next thirty (30) days copies of all employee W-4's and by the end of the probation submit a copy of all employee W-2's. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Laws & Rules class.

Breton, Glenn A. Hampstead, NC License# 32879 H-3-I

Allegations licensee violated probation in that the licensee failed to complete any of the requirements listed in the probation: (1) Did not attend any of the Mechanical Code courses, (2) Did not attend the Laws and Rules class, (3) Did not submit evidence to the board that the licensee obtained the applicable code books, (4) Did not return to and correct any of the code violations on the job listed in complaint file number 2017-433, did not submit a copy of the permit and did not submit a copy of the final approved inspection; (4) Did not submit quarterly reports

Resolution Conference held 12/112020. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Glenn Breton, number 32879 H-3-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of nine (9) months. Among other requirements during the suspension, within sixty (60) days of the approval of this agreement the contractor shall obtain a permit from the local code enforcement official, return to this structure at James B. White Highway South, Whiteville, NC and correct any and all code violations that still exist. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Mechanical Code courses and the Laws & Rules class. Upon successful completion of the suspension, his license, number 32879 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months.

Brinkley, Jimmy Advanced Air Technologies Hubert, NC License# 29111 H-2&3-I

Allegations licensee failed to obtain permit(s) prior to commencing work, failed to request inspections within 10 days of substantial completion of work, failed to obtain final inspections, failed to provide adequate supervision, violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Mechanical Code, and engaged in business under a different name or style of business than appears on his/her license.

Resolution Conference held on 12/11/2020 The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Jimmy Brinkley, number 2911 H-2&3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Christman, Benjamin Affordable Christman Plumbing. Southport, NC License# 33638 P-II

Allegations licensee contracted several P-I jobs as a subcontractor from a P-I licensed contractor while not being a bona-fide em-

ployee of a P-I licensee.

Resolution Conference held 12/11/2020 The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Benjamin Christman, number 33638 P-II, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Cooper, Phillip T. PT Cooper Remodeling Co Raleigh, NC License# 22734 H-3-I

Allegations licensee aiding and abetting an unlicensed person (Keith Moore), violated probation (probation from January 1, 2019 through July 9, 2020) in that he failed to perform load calculation(s), pulled a permit based on unlicensed Keith Moore saying they had a job but did not have a written contract, failed to provide supervision, allowed the use of license by unlicensed persons, failed to hold a written contract on a job where the permit was pulled, obtained a permit on a job and failed to meet the following rule requirement: the person who performed the work was not a bona-fide employee of the licensee, the licensee did not perform any work until after the homeowner contacted the inspection department and found out that the licensee pulled the permit, the licensee failed to hold a contract with Mrs. Bunn, and the licensee did not

receive all of the contractual payment. Resolution Conference held on 12/21/2020 The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Phillip Thomas Cooper, number 22734 H-3-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of six (6) months. The licensee shall enroll in, attend and complete the series of Special Contractor Business Management courses. Upon successful completion of the suspension, his license, number 22734 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months. Other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Dew, Kelvin Dewpoint Heating & Cooling, LLC Newport, NC License# 33201 H-3-II

Allegations licensee failed to perform a load calculation for the installation of a 4-ton split system heat pump system and duct work in the crawl space, failed to ensure a mechanical permit was obtained prior to commencing work, and failed to ensure proper system operation.

Kelvin Dew signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 12/07/2020. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Kelvin Dew, number 33201 H-3-II, and that of the firm shall be placed on a supervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Evans, David K. II Delta T Services, Inc. Clayton, NC License# 34029 H-3-I

Allegations licensee failed to obtain a mechanical permit for the replacement of broken sections of supply runs and broken sections of the main trunk line for the hvac

system.

David Evans signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 12/07/2020.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of David Evans II, number 34029 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on a supervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Fortiscue, William

Indoor Mechanical Service, LLC Rocky Point, NC License# 30752 H-3-II

Allegations that the licensee failed to obtain permit(s) prior to commencing work, failed to request inspections within 10 days of substantial completion of work, failed to obtain final inspections, violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Mechanical Code, return duct laying on the ground and is kinked due to beam on underside of the home, supply run to master bedroom is laying on the ground, supply duct connecting to the unit is laying on the ground and is excess in length resulting in unnecessary curves of duct work, rain shield is not mechanically fastened to the home and current silicone sealing is coming loose resulting in cracks, p-trap at unit does not have purple primer, old supply location is not sealed properly, failed to carry out adequate ductwork installation and system design, installation performed in a poor workman like manner / poor workmanship, and failed to perform proper load calculation(s). Resolution Conference held 12/10/2020. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of William Fortiscue, number 30752 H-3-II, and that of

the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other things during the probation, if allowed by the homeowner, within sixty (60) days of approval of this agreement the licensee shall return to the home at Cartertown Road perform a load calculation and a duct design to cover the additional duct work for the closet and if the calculations and/or design reveal any issues (with sizing) then the licensee shall return to this job and correct the equipment sizing and/or duct design issues, and shall also include correcting all existing code violations (ducts, boots, rain shield, joint construction, etc.) to assure that the complete installation meets or exceeds the minimum standard of the code. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course and the series of Special Mechanical Code courses.

Fullman, Peter M. Island Hardware & Maintenance, LLC Bald Head Island, NC License# 25466 PH-3-I

Allegations licensee allowed the use of the license by a non-P-I licensed person, on at least two jobs, contracted P-I work, then subcontracted the P-I work to Benjamin Paul Christman who only holds a P-II license, thus Mr. Christman is unlicensed to contractor or perform P-I work.

Resolution Conference held 12/10/2020. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Peter Fullman, number 25466 PH-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. The terms of the Proposed Resolution Agreement also include a requirement to enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Gandy, Gary L. Air Handlers II Sneads Ferry, NC License# 21359 H-2&3-I

Allegations licensee failed to provide supervision, failed to perform load calculation(s), when load calculations were performed the licensee confirmed that he was using a 20year-old calculation program, allowed the use of license by unlicensed persons by issuing 1099's or in cash to unlicensed persons, failed to execute contracts, and violations in this complaint are very consistent with previous violations complaint file number 2012-276 that resulted in a suspension of the license.

Resolution Conference held 12/09/2020. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Gary Gandy, number 21359 H-2&3-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of twenty-four (24) months. Among other requirements during the suspension, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course. Upon successful completion of the suspension, his license, number 21359 H-2&3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months.

The terms of the Proposed Resolution Agreement also include a requirement to enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Hamill, Jean Carroll Grimesland, NC License# 9377 H-3-I

Allegations of misconduct, failure to obtain permits and final inspections, failure to provide adequate supervision, improper license issuance in reference to complaint file num-

bers 2019-156, 2020-311 and 2020-312. Resolution Conference held 12/23/2020 The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended accepting that the license of Jean Hamill, number 9377 H-3-I, be surrendered to the Board. The act of surrendering his license to the Board will considered a license revocation.

Jumpp, Andre Hope Mills, NC License# 32982 H-3-I

Allegations licensee failed to obtain permit(s) prior to commencing work, failed to request inspections within 10 days of substantial completion of work, failed to obtain final inspections, failed to provide supervision, failed to perform load calculation(s), obtained a permit and allowed his license number to appear on a permit on a job where the licensee did not hold the contract with the homeowner or general contractor and did not receive the contractual payment for the job, and licensee was not actively employed for the firm that he was licensing (Ryan Air) and the licensee was receiving \$1,000 monthly with the understanding that Ryan Stephens was to notify the licensee when work requiring the license. In addition, the licensee was to receive a

separate fee for each job. Resolution Conference held 12/23/2020. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license Andre Jumpp, number 32982 H-3-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the suspension, within thirty (30) days of approval of this agreement the licensee shall refund to the homeowner the sum of \$2,200.00. The licensee shall submit evidence to the board within forty-five (45) days that this amount has been refunded. If the licensee refunds the above fee within the thirty (30) days as listed above then the suspension will be reduced from twelve (12) months to a nine (9) month suspension and enroll in, attend and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

McCarty, Michael E. McCarty Heating & Cooling Jamestown, NC License# 22179 H-3-I

Allegations licensee failed to provide adequate supervision and failed to comply with the bona-fide employee rule 21 NCAC

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Michael McCarty signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 12/02/2020.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license Michael McCarty, number 22179 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Mulchi, Kenneth L. First Choice A/C & Heating Inc. Indian Trail, NC License# 22645, H-3-II

Allegations licensee failed to provide adequate supervision, the licensee failed to obtain a permit in violation of the North Carolina State Building Code, and the licensee failed to obtain inspections in violation of the

North Carolina State Building Code. Kenneth Mulchi signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 12/10/2020.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Kenneth Mulchi, number 22645, H-3-II, and that of the firm shall be placed on an unsupervised probation for a period of 12 months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Peele, Jeffery Edgar Action Heating & Cooling, LLC Charlotte, NC

License# 24479 H-3-I (Retired) Allegations licensee violated the previous probation, then allowed the license to retire before the institution of a suspension. Jeffery Peele signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 12/07/2020.

Agreement 12/07/2020. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that Jeffery Edgar Peele is approved to sit for the Heating Group 3 examination (either technician or contractor). Upon passing the exam the license, number 24479, shall be suspended for a period of six (6) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Rogers, Seth M. **Pipeline Plumbing, Inc.** Emerald Isle, NC License# 29237 P-I Allegations licensee failed to respond to the

board's Administrative Officer after multiple attempts, failed to obtain permit(s) prior to commencing work for the replacement of a water heater on a multi-family dwelling, failed to request inspections within 10 days of substantial completion of work, failed to obtain final inspections, failed to list his current home addresses with the board within 30 days of moving, failed to provide adequate supervision, and violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Plumbing Code

Resolution Conference held 12/10/2020.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Seth Rogers, number 29237 P-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, licensee shall always respond to the Board within an appropriate timeframe in the future, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Plumbing Code and Design courses and the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Attorney's Report

The Attorney's Report contains information pertaining to cases that have been adjudicated in a formal proceeding of the Board or in the courts of North Carolina. Disciplinary actions against licensed contractors are typically imposed during a Formal Hearing of the Board. Court action is necessary when unlicensed individuals are in violation of the Board's Laws and Rules or in circumstances where licensees

are found to be in violation of any order(s) issued by the Board.

Boyd, Kenneth W. Carolina Beach, NC

Allegations of plumbing and heating contracting without a valid license. Judgment of Permanent Injunction filed 2/3/21 enjoining the Defendant from engaging in business as a plumbing or heating contractor until properly licensed to do so.

Clark, Tranis

Leland, NC

Allegations of heating contracting without a valid license. Judgment of Permanent Injunction filed 12/4/20 enjoining the Defendant from engaging in business as a plumbing or heating contractor until properly licensed to do so. Corporate Defendant served 12/11/20. Individual Defendant served 12/14/20.

Diggs, Curtis J. Smithfield, VA

Allegations of plumbing contracting without a license. Judgment of Permanent Injunction filed 12/4/20 enjoining the Defendant from engaging in business as a plumbing or heating contractor until properly licensed to do so. Defendant served 1/5/21.

Doty, Claud R. Banner Elk, NC

Allegations of heating contracting without a valid license. Judgment of Permanent Injunction filed 12/2/20 enjoining the Defendant from engaging in business as a plumbing or heating contractor until properly licensed to do so.

Edmisten, Larry M. Lenoir, NC

Allegations of plumbing contracting without a Hill, Brandon S. license. Judgment of Permanent Injunction filed 1/27/21 enjoining the Defendant from engaging in business as a plumbing or heating contractor until properly licensed to do so.

Fowler, Mark C. Whitsett. NC

Allegations of heating contracting without a valid license. Judgment of Permanent Injunction filed 1/22/21 enjoining the Defendant from engaging in business as a plumbing or heating contractor until properly licensed to do so. Defendant served 2/1/21.

Gillis, Charles G. Hayesville, NC
