Legislature Takes Action to Enable R-value Reductions for HVAC Ductwork in Response to Industry Supply Chain Issues

In response to HVAC industry concerns around on-going supply chain issues and the lack of available inventories of certain types of flexible ductwork, the North Carolina General Assembly passed temporary legislation to address the issue, which was signed into law by Governor Cooper on March 17th. This will make it easier for HVAC contractors to purchase flex-duct desperately needed to complete jobs currently in progress as well as jobs contracted in the future.

A letter was sent to all heating contractor licenses with a valid email address on file with the Board. It is vitally important that you provide the Board with a current email address so that we can communicate with you on any licensing and trade concerns.

The letter was also made available via a link on the Board's website homepage. You may read it below:

I am pleased to announce that the North Carolina General Assembly advanced House Bill 243 to Governor Roy Cooper and the Governor signed this legislation yesterday, March 17, 2022. This new law temporarily changes the Commercial and Residential insulation R-value for ducts installed in ventilated and non-ventilated unconditioned spaces (crawlspaces and attics). This law will allow for reduced duct insulations values for a period of two years. This law is now in effect.

Based on this legislation, contractors can install ducts in Residential ventilated and non-ventilated unconditioned spaces (crawlspaces and attics) with a minimum of R-4.2 insulation. Any changes in duct insulation values are required to be included in your load calculation. Please be aware that if you install any duct work under R-6 in an attic space, you will be increasing the potential of condensation formation on the ducts and the potential for mold growth in the attic and the home.

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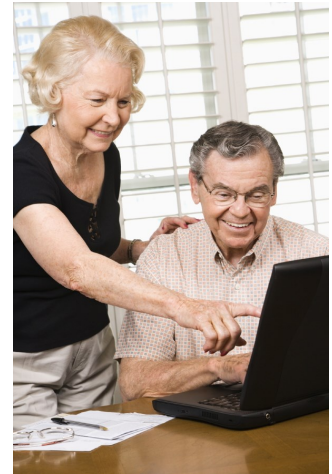

Resolution Agreements

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. Listed below are the different agreements entered into by the field staff and the Resolution Review Committee that have been approved by the Board. The information below does not contain all of the facts or details of each case. Allegations that licensee failed to obtain permit(s) prior to commencing work for the replacement of a water heater from a tank type to a tankless, then after the install the unit was relocated to the attic, failed to request inspections within 10 days of substantial completion of work for installed, failed to obtain final inspections, failed to provide

adequate supervision, violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Plumbing Code, violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Fuel Gas Code, violated probation, and licensed the firm G & A Plumbing while being actively employed for the firm and where work was performed under the license while the licensee was actively employed elsewhere. Resolution Conferences held 12/06/2021. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and

recommended that the license of Christopher Batchelor, number 26876 P-I, number 21511 P-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the suspension, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course. Upon successful completion of the suspension, his license, number 21511 P-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months. Among other require-

ments during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Plumbing Code and Design courses.

Allegations that licensee performed licensed plumbing work prior to obtaining a permit, and subcontracted work from an unlicensed general contractor in violation of GS 87-21 and the Board laws and rules section .0402. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Jessie Benson, number 33336 P-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Cameron Best, number 33655 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Among other requirements during the probation, if allowed by the homeowner, within 30 days of approval of this agreement the licensee shall return to the home located at 17 Masters Ct. pull a permit from the local code enforcement official, correct any code issues, and obtain a final passing inspection within sixty (60) days of approval of this agreement. Within seventy (70) days of approval of this agreement the licensee shall submit to the board evidence of the passing final inspection. This work shall be performed at the expense of the licensee.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Edgar Chance, number 28995 H-3-I shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Dennis, number 23805 P-II, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, within 30 days of the approval of this agreement, the contractor shall return to the homes located at 134 Main St., obtain a permit from the local code enforcement official, correct all of the code violations on the plumbing system and obtain a final inspection within 45 days of this agreement. Within 60 days of approval of this agreement the licensee shall submit evidence to the board of the final approved plumbing inspection. This work shall be performed at the expense of the licensee. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Plumbing Code and Design courses and the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that Franklin LaVerne Faircloth, Jr., license number 34593 H-2&3-I is denied sitting for the plumbing examination. In addition, the board will not accept any previous plumbing experience of Franklin LaVerne Faircloth, Jr. and will only accept plumbing experience from December 8, 2021, and going forward for any future application for plumbing license. In addition, the license of Franklin Faircloth, number 34593 H-2&3-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements during the suspension, within 30 days of approval of this agreement, assure that his license has been listed with the Board in the name that he currently operates his business and enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Allegations the licensee failed to perform load calculations on work performed under the license, pulled permits for work contracted and performed by Ruben Hernandez, unlicensed, allowed the use of license by unlicensed persons, and obtained a permit and allowed his license number to appear on a permit on a job where the licensee did not hold the con-

tract with the homeowner or general contractor, the licensee did not supervise, the installation was not performed by the licensee or bona-fide employees of the licensee and did not receive the contractual payment for the job.

Resolution Conference held 11/09/2021. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Charles Fortune, number 22357 H-3-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of nine (9) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Daniel Gregory, number 33336 P-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall submit to the Board's office within the next thirty (30) days copies of all employee W-4's and by the end of the probation submit a copy of all employee W-2's.

Allegations that the licensee allowed the use of the license by an unlicensed person, obtained two permits and allowed his license number to appear on two permits contracted by an unlicensed person, on two jobs where the licensee did not hold the contract with the homeowner or general contractor, the licensee nor the bona-fide employees of the licensee performed the work, and the licensee did not receive the contractual payment for the jobs, and installation performed under the permit violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Mechanical Code, and failed to provide supervision.

Resolution Conference held 12/9/2021. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Dan Griffin, number 14637 H-3-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of six (6) months. Among other requirements during

the suspension, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course. Upon successful completion of the suspension, his license, number 14637 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on supervised probation for a period of twenty-four (24) month.

Allegations of gross negligence in allowing the use of his license by the firm after the licensee moved to Utah and during the time the licensee had obtained employment in Utah, licensee failed to provide proper supervision, failed to execute contracts for work performed under his license, and misconduct in that the licensee held employment elsewhere (in Utah), yet allowed people to work under his license, and failed to meet with the Board's investigator because he started his new job in Utah and was not able to appear before the RRC.

Resolution Conference held 12/10/2021. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Kilo Krahn, number 28234 P-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of twelve (12) months.

Allegations the licensee failed to appear at the resolution conference. Invitation letter to conference delivered by certified mail to last known address 02/22/2021. Resolution Conferences held 03/19/2021 and

07/23/2021. Conference results sent by regular mail and certified mail to Florida address. Certified mail returned unclaimed. Licensee filed objection. Resolution Conference held 12/10/2021. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Robert Krenarch, number 09919, PH-1,3-I, H-2, license, number 28234 P-I, and the license of the firm be suspended for a period of twelve (12) months.

Allegations that the licensee failed to properly size, design and install a new mechanical system, and failed to obtain final inspections within ten (10) days of substantial completion of the work. William Morris signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 01/06/2022.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of William Morris, number 26990, H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve months. Among other requirements during the probation, by January 20th, 2022, the contractor shall return to the home located at 3077 Channel View Cove, and perform a thorough Manual J load calculation, Manual D duct design and a Manual S equipment sizing calculation. If the calculations reveals that the equipment or ductwork is improperly sized, then the contractor shall obtain a permit from the local inspection department, replace the improperly designed, sized equipment and ductwork with properly designed, sized equipment and ductwork and obtain a final inspection by January 27th, 2022. The contractor shall submit evidence to the board by February 1st, 2022, of the final inspection and shall submit a copy of all of the calculations. This work shall be performed at no expense to the homeowners.

like for like change out of an hvac system without performing a load calculation in violation of 21 NCAC 50.0505 (f). Christopher Smith signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 12/07/2021. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Christopher Smith, number 24539, H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Mechanical Code courses, the series of Special Fuel Gas Code and Design courses and the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Allegations the licensee allowed his license number to be used on a hvac permit for a job contracted between Joe Ogburn of Design Mechanical and the homeowner, and the licensee was not involved with the project, nor did he receive any money for the use of his license number.

Tony Underwood signed a Proposed Resolution Agreement 10/22/2021.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Tony Underwood number 22035 H-3-I, and that of

the firm shall be placed on a supervised probation for a period of eighteen (18) months. Among other requirements during the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Attorney's Report

The Attorney's Report contains information pertaining to cases that have been adjudicated in a formal proceeding of the Board or in the courts of North Carolina. Disciplinary actions against licensed contractors are typically imposed during a Formal Hearing of the Board. Court action is necessary when unlicensed individuals are in violation of the Board's Laws and Rules or in circumstances where licensees are found to be in violation of any order(s) issued by the Board.
