Documentation of Applicant Experience

The Board currently issues 28 different licenses, 25 of which require documentation of hands-on experience. (Fire sprinkler installation and inspection contractors require nationally recognized certifications.)

If the applicant has gained part or all of the required experience under the supervision of a licensee of this Board, it is the supervising licensee's responsibility to complete the appropriate form at the request of the applicant on the Current / Past North Carolina Licensed Employer Statement, which is part of the application package. The applicant is responsible for entering his/her full name, and indicating which qualifications are being sought before giving the form to the licensee for completion.

The licensee verifying the experience is responsible for entering the employment dates, the details of the applicant's duties while employed by the firm, the percentages of work that were service and repair or installation and design, and the total hours that the applicant performed installation, maintenance, service and repair. The licensee must also list his/her name, license number, firm name (if applicable) and the verification must be notarized.

From time to time, the Board receives a report from an applicant that a licensee is delaying or completely refusing the completion of the verification form. We also receive reports from licensees who question their role in verifying the experience of an applicant who they may not think would make a good licensee due to questions regarding their knowledge, skills, abilities or character.

The responsibility of the licensee is to honestly and accurately report the applicant's experience, regardless of their personal opinion of the applicant, and to do so in a timely manner following the applicant's request.

It is not the responsibility of the licensee to determine whether the applicant is qualified to be a licensee based on their personal knowledge or opinion of the applicant's knowledge, skills, abilities or moral character.

The Board requires that all applicants include information on the application regarding any criminal charges or convictions, as well as requiring a comprehensive criminal background report to be submitted with the application. If the Board identifies any issues during the application review, the applicant is required to meet with the Board's review committee to explain the offenses in person. The review committee will determine if the applicant will be allowed to sit for the exam, will need to wait a certain period of time before testing, or will be denied the opportunity to test.

If an applicant reports a licensee who is unwilling to verify experience, the licensee will be contacted by an Administrative Officer of the Board and will be reminded of the responsibility to verify the experience. If the licensee continues to refuse the request, it may lead to disciplinary action by the Board.

If a licensee has information concerning the applicant's work history, criminal history or moral character which he/she believes should be brought to the attention of the Board, the licensee should submit the concerns to the Board's Executive Director in writing immediately after completing the verification form.

The Board both recognizes and appreciates the vitally important role that licensees play in the industry by documenting and verifying the experience of applicants. To help insure the strength and integrity of the plumbing, HVAC, fuel piping and fire sprinkler trades into the future, it is extremely important for experienced contractors to both encourage and assist those who are interested in obtaining technician and/or contractor licensing in their respective trades.

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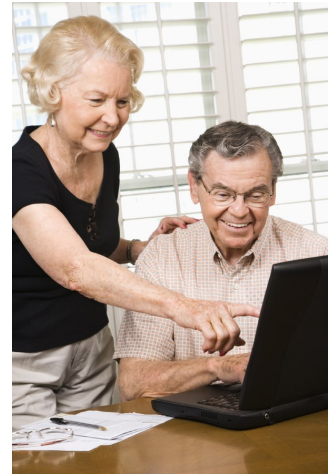

Resolution Agreements

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. Listed below are the different agreements entered into by the field staff and the Resolution Review Committee that have been approved by the Board. The information below does not contain all of the facts or details of each case. Allegations licensee allowed the use of license by unlicensed persons, aided and abetted an unlicensed person, obtained a permit and allowed his license number to appear on a permit on a job where the licensee did not hold the contract with the homeowner or general contractor, the work under this con-

tract was not performed by the licensee or bona-fide employees of the licensee and did not receive the contractual payment for the job, permitted a job where the job was contracted by Mr. Patino with the homeowner and Mr. Patino does not hold a GC license and pulled the permit for Mr. Flores who does not hold a license from our board, failed to hold an executed contract with the owner or licensed general contractor on the job.

Resolution Conference held 01/02/2024. The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Brandon Bake, license number 34239 H-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Mark Boone signed Proposed Resolution Agreement 01/23/2024.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Mark Boone, Jr number 30427 H-2-3-I, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of eighteen months. Among other requirements during the probation, by February 5th, 2024, the contractor shall return to the home located at 127 Splash Lane, pull the required permit, address the issues noted by the inspector, and perform a thorough Manual J load calculation, Manual D duct design and a Manual S equipment sizing calculation. If the calculations reveals that the equipment or ductwork is improperly sized, then the contractor shall obtain a permit from the local inspection department, replace the improperly sized equipment and ductwork with properly sized equipment and ductwork and obtain a final inspection by February 12th, 2024. The contractor shall submit evidence to the board by February 19th, 2024, of the final inspection and shall submit a copy of all of the calculations. This work shall be performed at no expense to the homeowners, and submit to the Board's office within the next thirty (30) days copies of all employee W-4's and by the end of the probation submit a copy of all employee W-2's.

Among other requirements during the probation, within 30 days of approval of this agreement the licensee shall submit to the Board's office copies of all employees W-4's and by the end of the probation submit a copy of all employees W-2's for each year of the probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course and complete the series of Special Plumbing Code and Design courses.

Among other requirements during the probation, by February 5th, 2024, the contractor shall return to the home located at 712 East 6th Street, pull the required permit and address the code violations and issues noted by the inspector. The corrections will be performed at no additional cost to the homeowner. The licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the series of Special Plumbing Code and Design courses and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Attorney's Report

The Attorney's Report contains information pertaining to cases that have been adjudicated in a formal proceeding of the Board or in the courts of North Carolina. Disciplinary actions against licensed contractors are typically imposed during a Formal Hearing of the Board. Court action is necessary when unlicensed individuals are in violation of the Board's Laws and Rules or in circumstances where licensees are found to be in violation of any order(s) issued by the Board.
