Annual License Renewal Begins in October

The 2025 license renewal period will begin on October 1, 2024. All licensees need to renew their license for the upcoming year prior to expiration on December 31st.

Failure to renew a license can result in denial of permits and disciplinary action by the Board if work is done on an expired license. Renewal notices containing usernames and passwords will be mailed to all licenses in early October. There are three ways to renew.

The first renewal option is through the online portal using a credit or debit card. You will need a valid email address to renew online. If you use this method, you should print your license following payment, as a printed copy will not be mailed from the Board's office if the license is renewed online.

The second option is to email the signed renewal form to the Board office, and a link will be sent for online payment. The license will not be renewed until payment is received.

The third option is to mail the signed renewal form to the Board's office with a check or money order. The renewal can not be processed until the form and payment are received.

Licensees who expired in 2021, 2022, or 2023 may renew by any of the methods above; however, online renewal requires that you pay for all expired years and 2024. If you wish to catch up on expired years but do not wish to renew for 2024, you must submit a paper form to do so.

Please note that if the license expired in 2021, it may be renewed until December 31, 2024. After that, the license will be retired, and the individual will be required to take and pass all applicable examinations in order to reinstate the license.

Board Continues to See Employee Misclassification Issues with

The purpose of this notification is to remind licensees that all laborers working under a licensed contractor must be bona-fide employees as defined in 21 North Carolina Administrative Code 50.0512 (Board Rules), which require that employees be

- 1) on the licensed contractor's payroll,
- 2) payroll taxes are withheld and the contractor performs other acts lawfully required of an employer (including the issuance of W2s at year end),
- 3) the contractor exercise control and supervision over the method, manner and details of the individual's work, and
- 4) the contractor is obligated to the property owner or general contractor for the work.

Contractors are also permitted to use employees who are contracted through a labor supplier, with a written contract that specifically places the payroll and tax withholding obligations on the contractor or labor supplier. The licensed contractor must meet the obligations in the previous paragraph and cannot be an employee contracted by or acting as a labor supplier.

Employee misclassification is defined in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 143-786(5) as avoiding tax liabilities and other obligations imposed by Chapter 95, 96, 97, 105, or 143 of the North Carolina General Statutes by misclassifying an employee as an independent contractor.

As a result of the Employee Fair Classification (EFCA) (Article 83, N.C.G.S. §143-785- §143-791), employee misclassification issues are monitored by the following agencies:

- the North Carolina Department of Labor;
- the North Carolina Department of Commerce's Division of Employment Security;
- the North Carolina Department of Revenue; and
- the North Carolina Industrial Commission

In addition, the North Carolina Industrial Commission issued the following nearly seven years ago: Public Notice Statement required by N.C. Gen. Stat. § 143-764(a)(5), effective December 31, 2017. Any worker who is defined as an employee by N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 95-25.2(4)(NC Department Of Labor), 143762(a)(3)(Employee Fair Classification Act), 96-1(b)(10)(Employment Security Act), 97-2(2)(Workers' Compensation Act), or 105-163.1(4)(Withholding; Estimated Income Tax for Individuals) shall be treated as an employee unless the individual is an independent contractor.

Any employee who believes that the employee has been misclassified as an independent contractor by the employee's employer may report the suspected misclassification to the Employee Classification Section within the North Carolina Industrial Commission:

Employee misclassification is defined as avoiding tax liabilities and other obligations imposed by Chapter 95, 96, 97, 105, or 143 of the North Carolina General Statutes by misclassifying an employee as an independent contractor. [N.C. Gen. Stat. § 143-762(5)].

The bottom line is that unless a written contract exists between a recognized labor supplier that assigns the payroll and tax withholding obligations to the labor supplier, all laborers must be bona-fide employees of the licensed contractor or the firm they qualify, and the contractor or their firm must assume full responsibility for payroll and tax withholding obligations.

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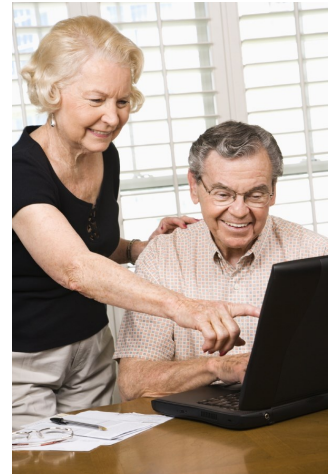

Resolution Agreements

A Field Resolution Agreement is a voluntary agreement by which a licensee enters into some type of sanctions against their license instead of appearing before the Resolution Review Committee or the Full Board at a formal hearing. All of the Agreements are reviewed by a member of the Resolution Review Committee and then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. If a complaint has not been resolved in the field through a Field Resolution Agreement, then the case can be referred to the Resolution Review Committee. During the Resolution Review Committee meeting, a licensee can enter into a Review Committee Resolution Agreement in place of appearing before the Board at a formal hearing; the agreement is then presented to a Board hearing panel for approval prior to the agreement being adopted as a final agency decision. Cases that cannot be resolved through the use of Field Resolution Agreements or Review Committee Resolution Agreements are forwarded to formal hearings before the Board. Listed below are the different agreements entered into by the field staff and the Resolution Review Committee that have been approved by the Board. The information below does not contain all of the facts or details of each case. Allegations licensee failed to provide supervision, violated the minimum standard of the North Carolina State Mechanical Code, created risk of personal injury or property damage, created a situation in the control wiring that increased the air volume and increased the humidity levels in the ducting system, and failed to respond to the consumer in a timely manner.

Resolution Conference held 09/21/2023. Licensee failed to attend.

Results hand delivered to respondent on 11/28/2023.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of John Armstrong, number 19675 H-1,2&3-I shall be

placed on supervised probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months. Among other requirements during probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Allegations of misconduct, selling license, and failure to respond to consumer in a timely manner.

Resolution Conference held 11/27/2023. Licensee failed to attend.

Results served by certified mail to address in Philippi, WV.

The Review Committee found that based on the violations of allowing the use of the license by an unlicensed person, issuing 1099's

to unlicensed persons, and having the license listed illegally, it is the decision that the license of Donald Allen Bennett, license number 29150 P-I and that of the firm A & D Plumbing, LLC, shall be suspended until such time that Mr. Bennett appears before the Resolution Review Committee to answer to the charges based in the complaint..

Brown, Travis J. Cornerstone Gas Services, LLC Mount Pleasant, SC License# 30512 FP

Allegations of failed to provide supervision, licensee of the firm was actively employed full-time by a gas company located in the southeastern region of South Carolina yet licensed a North Carolina firm in Western North Carolina (about 280 miles away), failed to execute contract(s),

failed to be in the office or one the jobs contracted out of the office a minimum of 1,500 hours annually and received a fee of \$500.00 per month to license the firm.

Resolution Conference held 05/06/2024.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of Travis Brown, license number 30512 FP, and that of the firm be suspended for a period of 90 days.

The Review Committee found that the allegations were supported by the evidence and recommended that the license of John Kevin Craft, license number 33164 FPT, and that of the firm shall be placed on unsupervised probation for a period of twelve (12) months. Among other requirements, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Among other requirements during probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course and submit to the Board's office within the next thirty (30) days copies of all employee W-4's and by the end of the probation submit a copy of all employee W-2's.

Among other requirements during probation, the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course and the series of Special Plumbing Code and Design courses.

This work shall be performed at no expense to the homeowners; by May 5th, 2024, the contractor shall address or compensate the homeowner for any damages caused during the HVAC installation; and the licensee shall enroll in, attend, and complete the Special Board Laws & Rules course.

Attorney's Report

The Attorney's Report contains information pertaining to cases that have been adjudicated in a formal proceeding of the Board or in the courts of North Carolina. Disciplinary actions against licensed contractors are typically imposed during a Formal Hearing of the Board. Court action is necessary when unlicensed individuals are in violation of the Board's Laws and Rules or in circumstances where licensees are found to be in violation of any order(s) issued by the Board.
